Happy New Year and I hope you got some time to relax over the Festive Season.

This time of year is always special for me and my family. My three little ones had a great Christmas, and spent the summer holidays relaxing at home and running under the sprinkler on hot days.

I have been thinking of you all over this period, and reflecting on how deeply proud I am to represent this incredible community: from Keysborough to Oakleigh, from East Bentleigh to Clayton, and everyone in between.

2023 will be the first full year of our new Federal Government. I am working really hard to deliver on the things you have told me matter most.

Last year, we got **real action on climate change** for the first time in a decade. Australia now has real emissions reduction targets, which are enshrined in law.

The Albanese Government helped deliver **wage rises for millions** of Australia's lowest paid workers, and new laws were passed to help get wages moving for many more Australians. For the first time in history, we passed laws for a **National Anti-Corruption Commission**. Integrity and trust are issues you raised with me during the election, and I fought hard for this reform to occur.

We got a lot done in 2022, but families in our community are also dealing with many challenges, in particular, the cost of living.

Some changes have been made to help on this front. At the end of last year, our Energy Price Relief Plan was adopted, **capping coal and gas prices on the east coast**.

We've also brought down the cost of many medicines.

A big difference will also be felt this year by **families that use childcare**. The way we fund childcare is changing, and almost all families will benefit from our changes with lower fees.

The cost of living will continue to be a big focus over the coming year.

I'm always keen to hear your view on the most important issues to you and your thoughts on the state of federal politics. An update on recent action taken:



National Anti-Corruption Commission Bill passed the Parliament – this will bring integrity and trust back into politics.



Acting on our emissions reduction targets of 43% this decade and net-zero by 2050.

- Introduced our Energy Price Relief Plan, capping coal and gas prices on the east coast, to ease energy prices and prepare for a better future.
- Secure Jobs, Better Pay Bill is now law this will get wages moving.
- Cheaper Child Care with 97% of families paying less 6,500 families in Hotham.



- Expanded Paid Parental Leave to six months to support working families.
- Cheaper medicines with a cap on the cost of prescriptions to help with the cost of living.
 - Supported a submission to the Fair Work Commission to get increased wages for aged care workers.
 - Action on Cyber Security introduced strong laws that will make sure companies keep your data safe.
 - In-depth review into our migration system. Designing a new migration system one that is fit for the 21st century.
- Developing a National Housing and Homelessness Plan to set out actions to improve housing outcomes.
 - Strengthening our relationships with international friends and neighbours.


Visiting our Close Neighbours

Energys Australia

It was wonderful to be at the Energys Australia launch of a megawatt scale hydrogen fuel cell facility right here in my Hotham electorate.

Energys Australia is a dedicated team of scientists, engineers, and energy experts working together to make a clean, sustainable hydrogen future a reality.

Energys Australia recently received a \$5 million Modern Manufacturing Initiative grant from the Australian Government to speed up their expansion and a \$1 million Victorian Government grant to establish a renewable hydrogen production facility.

The launch of this hydrogen facility is an excellent example of Australian tech creating jobs and increasing manufacturing and export opportunities - right here in our local community.

Queen's Jubilee Tree Planting Program

It's always exciting to drop into Valkstone Primary School in Bentleigh East and have a chat with students like School Captains Kynan and Yael.
